We now know that the words we use make a difference to our own energy and attitude.. Isn't that just amazing! We saw all these beautiful water crystals.

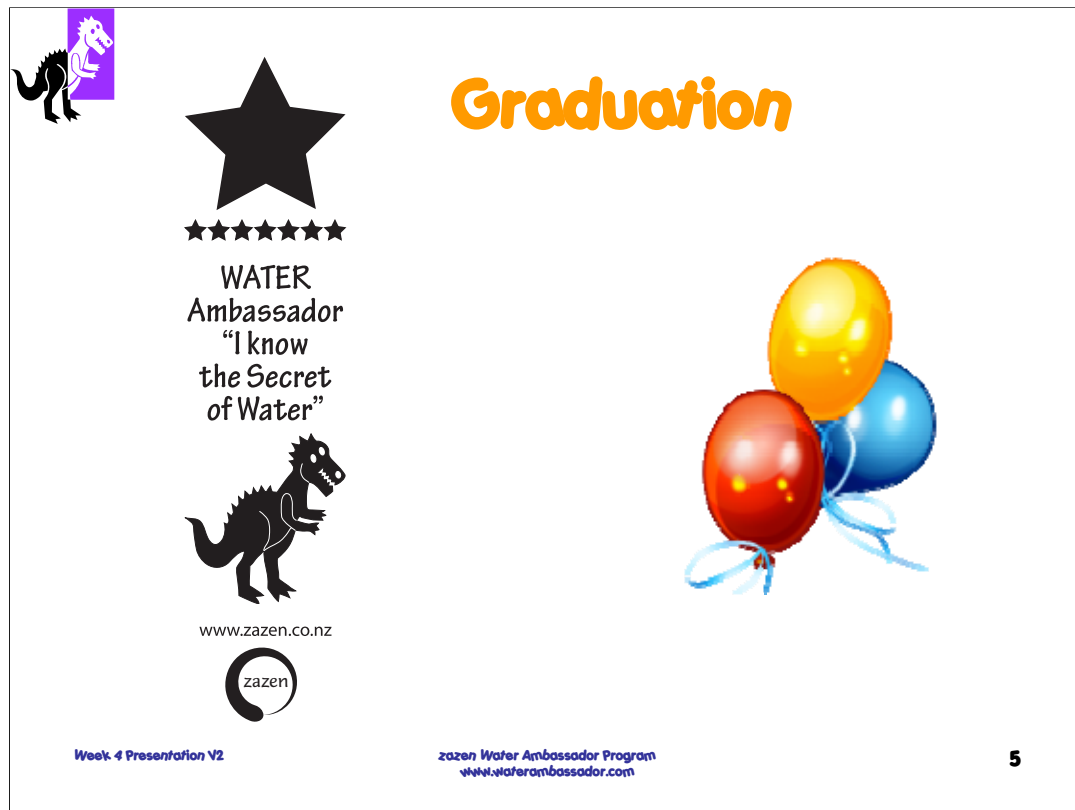
Who remembers What sort of music does water like??

Have the children line up – and with the aid of a teacher..

Congratulate the class and tell them they have a special job to do as Water Ambassadors. What does an ambassador do? They are like a very special representative – now they each can share their knowledge about water and hydration with others..

Now invite each child to step forward one after the other..

Shake their hand.. Looking them in the eyes and at their level (height).. say

“Congratulations..<name> You are now a Water Ambassador and know the secret of water.. Well done and thank you“

Hand the ribbon and the Pin to them.. And get the teacher to help them pin it on do the next until everyone is done (leave ribbons for those that are absent)
